



New Features in Amtelco Secure Messages Android App 7.0

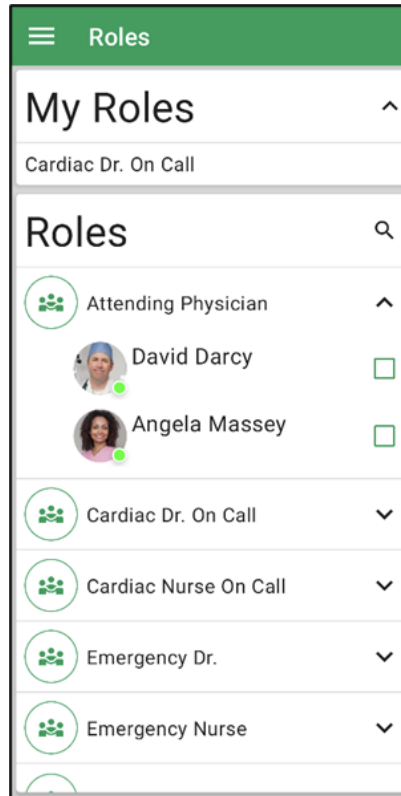

Note: Amtelco Secure Messages will prompt all users to enter their passcodes when upgrading to version 7.0.x, even if biometric authentication is enabled. Users with Single Sign-On (SSO) enabled will also need to re-authenticate after updating.

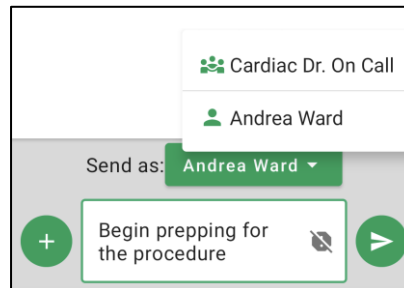
FEATURE	DESCRIPTION
Phone Dialer Screen 7.0.5.0	<p>The Phone Dialer Screen is used to dial a phone number.</p>  <p>If the optional Protected Dialing feature is enabled, calls made using the Phone Dialer are routed through your call center or organization so that their number is shown on the Caller ID instead of your device's number.</p>

FEATURE	DESCRIPTION
	<p>International numbers can be dialed by touching and holding the “0” (zero) key to add a plus sign (+) to the display followed by the country code and phone number. The Phone Dialer adjusts the format of the number to match the country code of the location you are dialing.</p> <p>Note: This feature requires Amtelco Secure Messages server version 7.0.</p>
<p>Role-Based Messaging 7.0.5.0 <i>optional feature</i></p>	<p>The optional Role-Based Messaging feature has been implemented. Role-Based Messaging synchronizes Intelligent Series (IS) OnCall Scheduling with Amtelco Secure Messages. Role-Based Messaging enables Amtelco Secure Messages users to retrieve assigned resources for IS on-call schedules, on-call shifts, and on-call roles and send messages to everyone filling a role.</p> <p>Note: This feature requires Amtelco Secure Messages server version 7.0 and Intelligent Series 5.7.</p> <div data-bbox="792 919 1198 1717" data-label="Image"> </div> <p>The Contacts Screen now displays roles as well as contacts. Roles added to a Contact Circle receive messages sent to the Contact Circle. Contacts or roles can be hidden or displayed by touching the Contacts/Roles buttons.</p>


The Roles Screen is used to view the roles that you are currently filling and to view and send messages to contacts filling roles.







The New Message Screen contains the Send As menu, allowing users to choose to send a message in their own name or to send a message as a role they are filling. Messages sent to or from a role stay with the role, not the user, allowing message threads to carry over from one shift to the next for seamless coverage.



<p>Copy Phone Numbers and Links to Clipboard</p> <p>7.0.5.0</p>	<p>Phone numbers, e-mail addresses, and web addresses can be copied to the clipboard.</p> <p>Touch and hold the phone number, e-mail address, or web address.</p> <p>If your administrator has given you the option to copy phone numbers, e-mail addresses, or web addresses, a menu is displayed.</p>

<p>Rebranding to Amtelco Secure Messages</p> <p><i>7.0.5.0</i></p>	<p>As part of the Amtelco rebrand, miSecureMessages has been renamed to Amtelco Secure Messages and features a new logo and default theme color. The former default blue and yellow theme color can be selected in the Theme Color Screen in Settings.</p> <div data-bbox="1068 625 1442 842" style="border: 1px solid black; padding: 10px; text-align: center;">  </div>
<p>Do Not Disturb Override Pop-up</p> <p><i>7.0.0.11</i></p>	<p>When launching the app for the first time, the Do Not Disturb Override pop-up is displayed.</p> <p>The Do Not Disturb Override pop-up asks if you would like miSecureMessages to override the phone's Do Not Disturb setting when receiving high priority messages. Overriding the Do Not Disturb setting allows Amtelco Secure Messages to play sounds when Do Not Disturb is enabled.</p>

	<div data-bbox="794 264 1195 1045"><p>Do Not Disturb Override miSecureMessages would like to override your phone's Do Not Disturb setting when high priority messages are received. To grant access, touch Go To Settings, find and touch miSecureMessages in the menu, then touch Allow Do Not Disturb.</p></div> <p>To override the Do Not Disturb setting, touch the Go To Settings button to display your phone's settings.</p> <p>Select "miSecureMessages" in the menu, and then touch "Allow Do Not Disturb."</p>

<p>Passcode Screen Help Link</p> <p>7.0.0.11</p>	<p>A Help hyperlink has been added to the Passcode Screen.</p>  <p>Touch the Help hyperlink to display the Passcode Help dialog box.</p>  <p>The Passcode Help dialog box shows information about how to reset your passcode and what to do if you have never set a passcode.</p> <p>Touch “Ok” to close the dialog box and return to the Passcode Screen.</p>
<p>High Contrast Theme Colors</p> <p>7.0.0.4</p>	<p>High contrast theme colors have been added to make it easier for those with visual impairments, such as colorblindness, to see and interact with the elements on the screen.</p> <p>To use the new high contrast theme colors, open the Settings Screen and touch Theme Color. The Theme Color dialogue box is displayed.</p>  <p>Select the desired theme color and then touch Save. The miSecureMessages screens are updated with the selected high contrast color theme.</p>

	 <p>A different color theme can be selected for each Amtelco Secure Messages account.</p>
<p>Full Version Number Toast Message 7.0.0.3</p>	<p>The full version number can now be displayed. Touch the shortened version number at the top of the Add New Account screen ten times to display the full version number. A small pop-up message appears at the bottom of the screen.</p>

	 <p>The version number pop-up message will display for a few seconds before automatically disappearing.</p>
<p>Complete Interface Redesign 7.0.0.0</p>	<p>The app interface has received a comprehensive visual overhaul. Design elements such as fonts, icons, and buttons have been updated to better reflect modern design principles, and several screens have been modified to make information easier to access.</p> <p>miSecureMessages Toolbar</p> <p>The miSecureMessages Toolbar has been simplified and now only contains the Menu icon, account name, and Notifications icon.</p>  <p>The Compose New Message icon has been moved to the Inbox Screen, the Personal Circle icon has been moved to the Contacts Screen, and accounts are selected from the Menu Drawer.</p> <p>Passwords and Passcodes</p> <p>When creating new passwords and passcodes, the complexity requirements are displayed above the text field and the requirements that have been met are now displayed in strikethrough text.</p>

	<div data-bbox="792 264 1195 758" data-label="Image"> </div> <p data-bbox="545 779 1396 848">The Visible  and Not Visible  icons are used to show or hide text in password and passcode fields.</p> <h3 data-bbox="545 869 737 900">Menu Drawer</h3> <p data-bbox="545 921 1442 991">The Menu Drawer now displays user profile information in the header and is divided into two menus: Pages and Groups.</p> <div data-bbox="792 1005 1195 1803" data-label="Image"> </div>

	<p>The Pages menu contains icons and the names of various screens within the Amtelco Secure Messages app. Web links are displayed in their own drop-down menu in the Pages menu.</p> <p>The Groups menu contains a list of Amtelco Secure Messages accounts that can be accessed.</p> <p>New Message Screen</p> <p>Subject, Priority, and Reply Mode have been moved from the Contacts Screen to the New Message Screen to be more easily accessible when creating a new message. Contacts can then be searched from the Find Contacts field or selected by touching Select From Contacts.</p> <div data-bbox="808 730 1182 1465" data-label="Image"> </div> <p>The names of the selected contacts and the message subject are displayed at the top of the New Message Screen.</p> <p>The priority is controlled via an icon in the Enter Message field.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Touch the No Exclamation Mark icon  to change the priority to High Priority. <p>Touch the red Exclamation Mark icon  to change a High Priority message back to Normal Priority, indicated by a gray No Exclamation Mark icon. </p>
