




New Features in Amtelco Secure Messages Apple App 7.0

Note: Amtelco Secure Messages will prompt all users to enter their passcodes when upgrading to version 7.0.x, even if biometric authentication is enabled. Users with Single Sign-On (SSO) enabled will also need to re-authenticate after updating.




FEATURE	DESCRIPTION
<p>Phone Dialer Screen</p> <p>7.0.5.0</p> <p><i>optional feature</i></p>	<p>The Phone Dialer Screen is an optional feature used to dial a phone number.</p> <div data-bbox="808 835 1179 1583"></div> <p>If the Protected Dialing feature is configured, calls made using the Phone Dialer are routed through your call center or organization so that their number is shown on the Caller ID instead of your device's phone number. If you do not have the Protected Dialing feature configured, phone calls placed with the Phone Dialer will show your device's phone number on the Caller ID.</p>



	<p>International numbers can be dialed by tapping and holding the “0” (zero) key to add a plus sign (+) to the display followed by the country code and phone number. The Phone Dialer adjusts the format of the number to match the country code of the location you are dialing.</p> <p>Note: This feature requires Amtelco Secure Messages server version 7.0.</p>
<p>Role-Based Messaging 7.0.4.0 <i>optional feature</i></p>	<p>The optional Role-Based Messaging feature has been implemented. Role-Based Messaging synchronizes Intelligent Series (IS) OnCall Scheduling with Amtelco Secure Messages. Role-Based Messaging enables Amtelco Secure Messages users to retrieve assigned resources for IS on-call schedules, on-call shifts, and on-call roles and send messages to everyone filling a role.</p> <div data-bbox="808 890 1182 1638" data-label="Image"> </div> <p>The Contacts Screen now displays roles as well as contacts. Roles added to a Contact Circle receive messages sent to the Contact Circle. Contacts or roles can be hidden or displayed by tapping the Contacts/Roles buttons.</p>

	<div data-bbox="792 268 1198 999" data-label="Image"> </div> <p data-bbox="545 1031 1365 1100">The Roles Screen is used to view the roles that you are currently filling and to view and send messages to contacts filling roles.</p> <div data-bbox="792 1127 1198 1352" data-label="Image"> </div> <p data-bbox="545 1383 1432 1575">The New Message Screen contains the Send As menu, allowing users to choose to send a message in their own name or to send a message as a role they are filling. Messages sent to or from a role stay with the role, not the user, allowing message threads to carry over from one shift to the next for seamless coverage.</p>

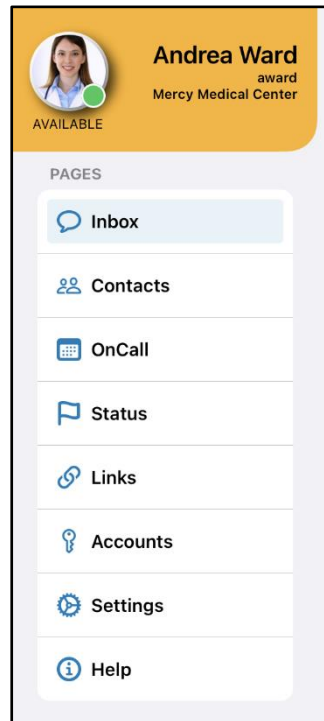

<p>Reorganization of Menu Drawer</p> <p>7.0.4.0</p>	<p>Links are now displayed in a drop-down menu in the Menu Drawer. Previously, links were located on the Links Page.</p> <p>Accounts, Settings, and Help have been moved to the Settings section in the Menu Drawer.</p> <div data-bbox="641 478 1338 730" style="border: 1px solid black; padding: 10px; margin: 10px 0;"> </div>
<p>Personal Circle Slider in Contact Information</p> <p>7.0.4.0</p>	<p>The Personal Circle slider has been added to the Contact Information pane.</p> <p>To display the contact information for an Amtelco Secure Messages user, tap the user’s photo on the Contacts Screen.</p> <div data-bbox="802 957 1187 1440" style="border: 1px solid black; padding: 10px; margin: 10px 0;"> </div> <p>The Personal Circle slider is displayed if the Personal Circle feature is enabled on your account.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To add the user to your Personal Circle, set the slider to the On position. • To remove the user from your Personal Circle, set the slider to the Off position.

<p>Rebranding to Amtelco Secure Messages</p> <p>7.0.4.0</p>	<p>As part of the Amtelco rebrand, miSecureMessages has been renamed Amtelco Secure Messages and features a new logo and default theme color. The former default blue and yellow theme color can be selected in the Theme Color Screen in Settings.</p> 	
<p>High Contrast Theme Colors</p> <p>7.0.0.0</p>	<p>High contrast theme colors have been added to make it easier for those with visual impairments, such as colorblindness, to see and interact with the elements on the screen.</p> <p>To use the new high contrast theme colors, open the Settings Screen and tap Theme Color. The Theme Color Screen is displayed.</p>  <p>Select the desired theme color and then tap Update. The miSecureMessages screens are updated with the selected high contrast color theme.</p>

	 <p>A different color theme can be selected for each miSecureMessages account.</p>
<p>Complete Interface Redesign 7.0.0.0</p>	<p>The app interface has received a comprehensive visual overhaul. Design elements such as fonts, icons, and buttons have been updated to better reflect modern design principles, and several screens have been modified to make information easier to access.</p> <p>miSecureMessages Toolbar</p> <p>The miSecureMessages Toolbar has been simplified and now only contains the Menu icon  and Notifications icon. </p>  <p>The Compose New Message icon has been moved to the Inbox Screen. Accounts are selected from the Menu Drawer.</p> <p>Passwords and Passcodes</p> <p>When creating new passwords and passcodes, the complexity requirements are displayed above the text field and the requirements that have been met are now displayed in strikethrough text.</p>

New Message Screen

Subject, Priority, and Reply Mode have been moved from the Contacts Screen to the New Message Screen to be more easily accessible when creating a new message. Contacts can be searched from the Find Contacts field or can be selected by tapping “Select From Contacts.”

	<div data-bbox="802 268 1187 930" data-label="Image"> </div> <p data-bbox="545 961 1349 1031">The names of the selected contacts and the message subject are displayed at the top of the New Message Screen.</p> <p data-bbox="545 1062 792 1094">Apple Watch App</p> <p data-bbox="545 1115 1422 1224">The Apple Watch App user interface has also been redesigned. Buttons, icons, and fonts on each screen have been updated to match the corresponding screens in the phone app.</p> <div data-bbox="683 1262 1312 1549" data-label="Image"> </div> <p data-bbox="545 1577 1443 1724">In addition to the redesign, the Apple Watch app now displays the last five threads in the user's inbox as well as the last five messages for each of those threads. In previous versions, only the last three threads and messages were displayed.</p>
