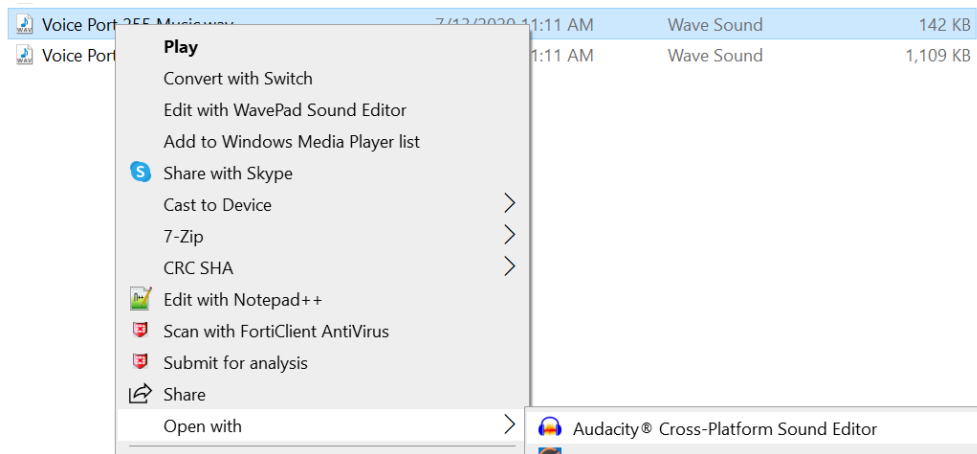


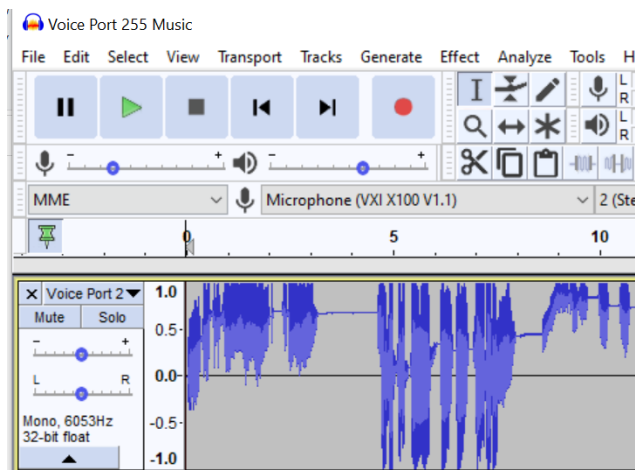
Convert Files Using Audacity for Infinity & Genesis 8k 16 bit Mono – Audacity v3.3.3 August 2023

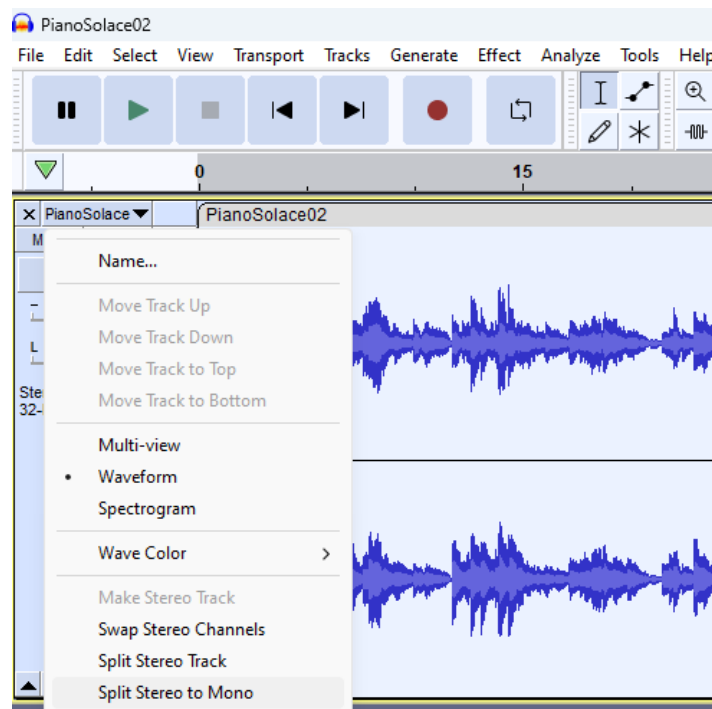
1. Open within Audacity or select the file and use “Open with” Audacity.



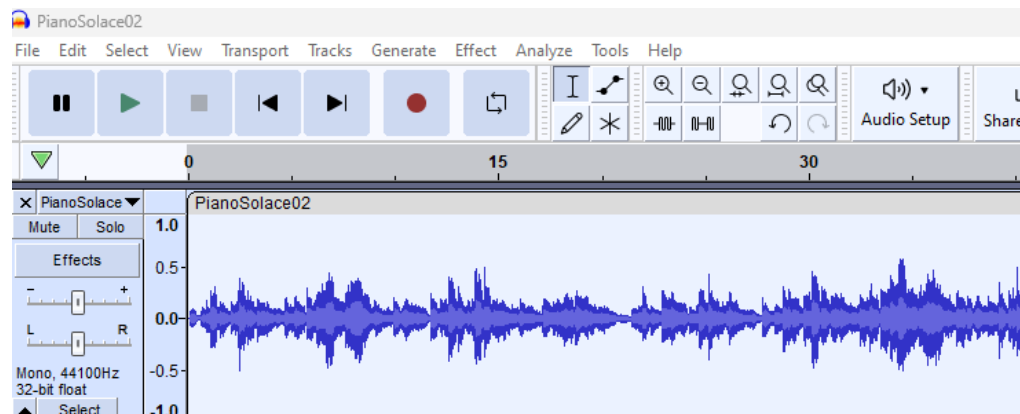
2. Play the file to ensure the sound quality is good (green Play icon)



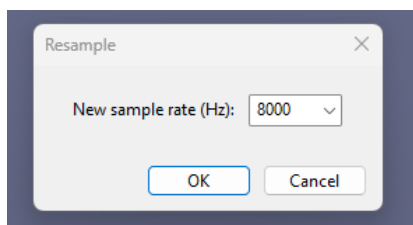
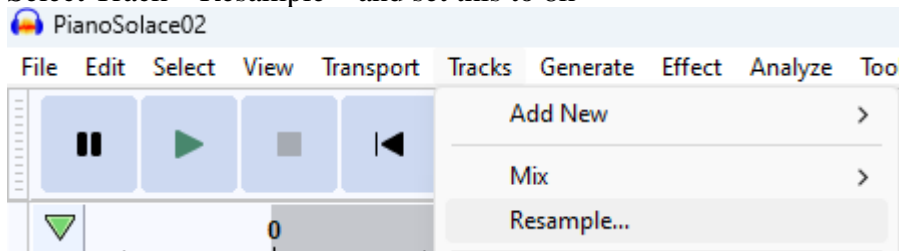
3. If necessary, convert from Stereo to Mono
 - a. Go to Select
 - b. Right-click on the Stereo format and select “Split Stereo to Mono”



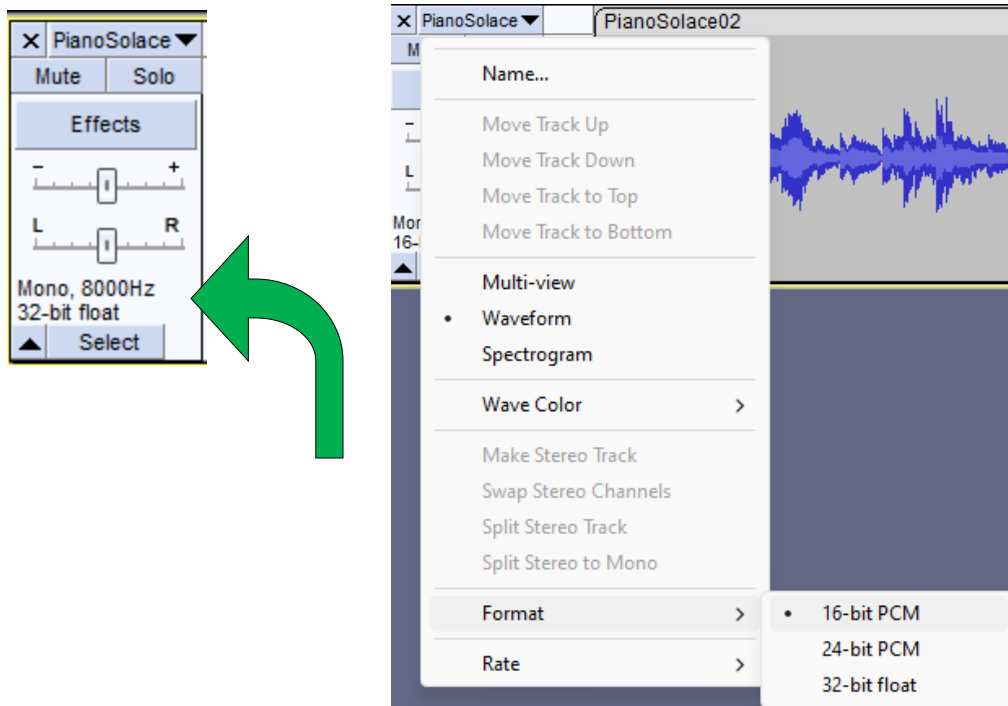
- c. This should produce 2 files, one of which can be deleted



4. Go to Select and choose your remaining music file
5. Select Track – Resample – and set this to 8k

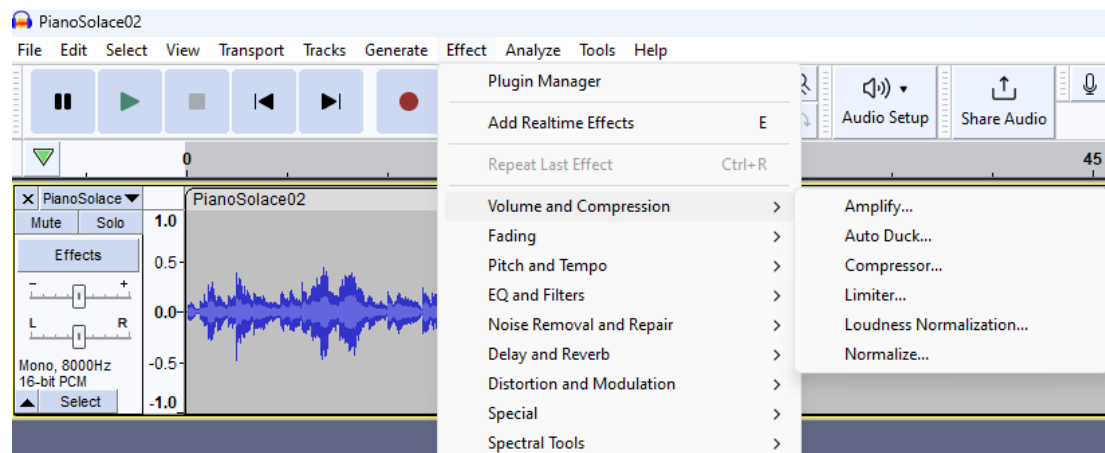


6. Right-click on the format, select Format – 16-bit

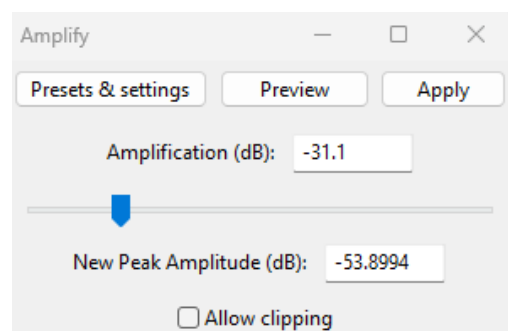


Please note: Audacity also has Effect options such as Noise Removal and Repair and Volume Compression.

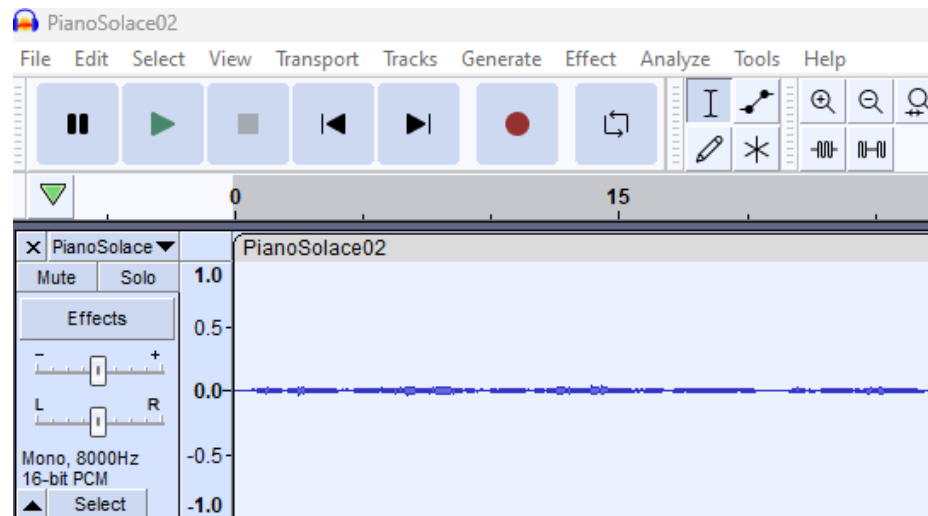
7. For example, to adjust the volume of your file
 - a. Go to Select and choose your file
 - b. Choose Effect – Volume and Compression – Amplify



- c. Pull the slider left (decrease volume) or right (increase volume) and Apply



The file should be noticeably lower:



8. When you have completed your alterations, go to File – Export – Export as WAV
